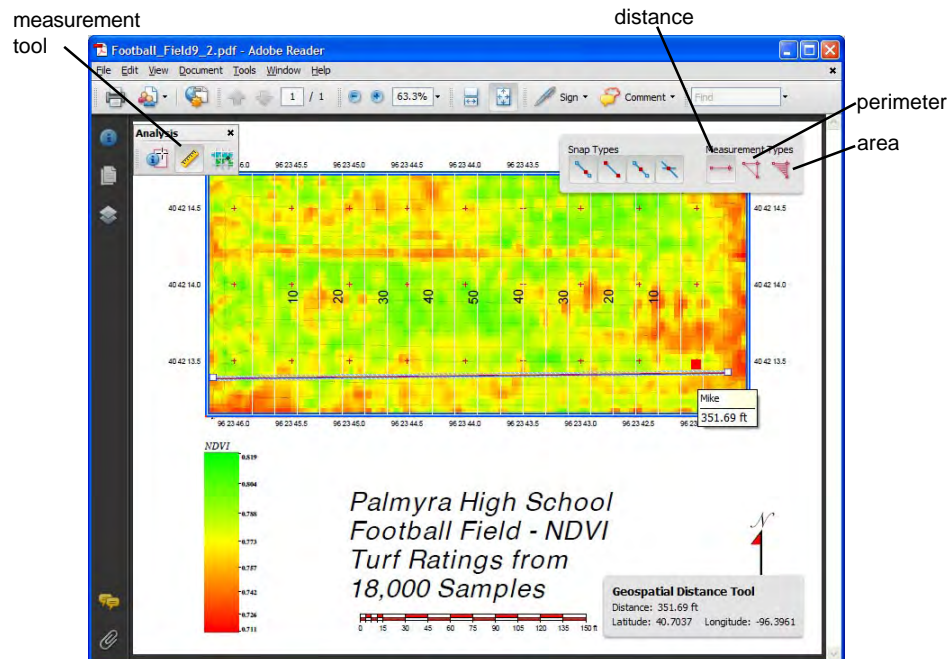


Measuring Geospatial PDFs with Reader

DID YOU KNOW . . . you can make measurements with Adobe Reader in geospatial PDFs that you render in TNTmips?

What Measuring in Adobe Reader Gives You

- Ability for others to make measurements in geospatial PDFs you provide
- Measure distance, area, and perimeter
- Choose your default measurement units for distance and area
- Enable measurement markup



How to Setup Measuring in Adobe Reader

- Open geospatial PDF rendered in TNT in Adobe Acrobat 9 Pro or higher.
- Select Advanced/Extend Features in Adobe Reader and Save.
- Open Adobe Reader and set default units and other preferences for measuring [Edit/Preferences/Measuring (Geo)].
- Check that Enable Measurement Markup is turned on in Preferences.
- Open Analysis toolbar if not open (Tools/Analysis/Show Analysis Toolbar)
- Click on the Measurement tool.
- Choose the desired measurement type and snap type.
- Make your measurements.
