

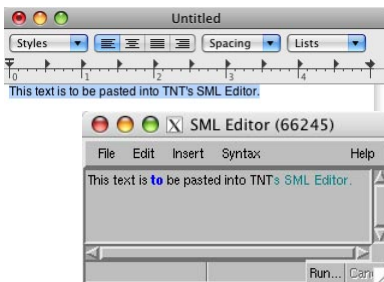
# Paste from Mac to TNTmips

**DID YOU KNOW** . . . you can copy from a text editor, browser, or other software and paste to a TNT window on the Mac?

## What Copying from Mac to TNT Windows Gives You

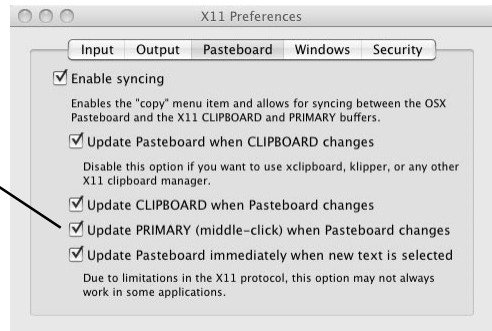
- Copy from text editor and paste into TNT Geoformula or SML script
- Paste text into layout text group
- Paste URL from browser to display a KML, remote tileset, WMS, or ArcIMS layer
- Paste a URL for HyperIndex Link

Copying from native Mac applications to TNT or other X11 applications requires X11 v2.3.4, which comes with Mac OS X 10.6 or XQuartz v2.4. This option must be on for pasting with the middle mouse button to work.



The above shows text selected for copying in the Mac Text Editor and pasted into the SML Editor.

If you do not have a 3-button mouse, hold the Option key and left-click.



URLs can be very long and difficult to type directly. You can copy the URL from your browser and paste it into the TNT selection window desired.

## How to Copy from Mac to TNT Windows

- Using Mac OS X 10.6, make sure X11 is using XQuartz 2.3.4 or
- Using Mac OS X 10.5.8, update X11 to use XQuartz 2.4.0 (go to <http://xquartz.macosforge.org/trac/wiki/X112.4.0> and download).
- Check "Update PRIMARY (middle-click) when Pasteboard changes" option in the X11 preferences.
- Copy text from any application or a URL from your browser (command C or Copy on menu).
- **Do not make any other selection** before pasting the text.
- Click on the TNT window to give it focus.
- Click the **middle mouse button** to paste the text.
